### EMPOWERING LEARNER ASSISTANTS: SPARKING RENEWAL AND GROWTH

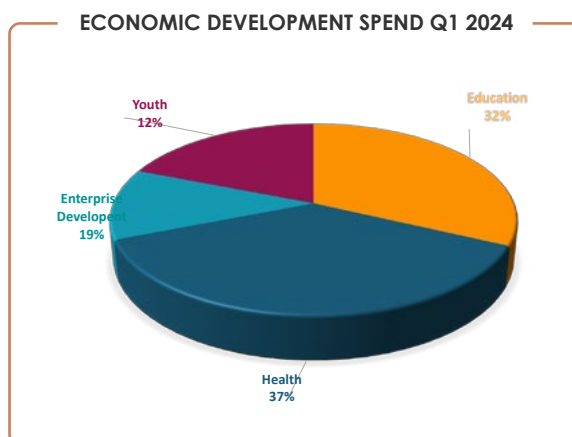
