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LEARNER ASSISTANTS TAKE TIME TO RECHARGE AND REFLECT

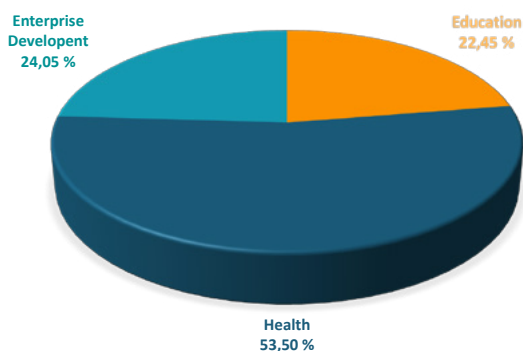


To show appreciation for the dedicated learner assistants who are the backbone of our reading programme, we hosted a rejuvenating retreat at Moreson Farm, in Taung.
