



CONGRATULATIONS! LEARNER ASSISTANTS RECEIVE CERTIFICATES

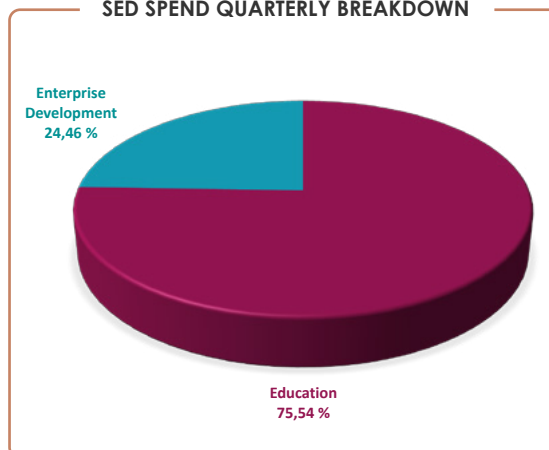
