## Soccer League Registration Support

We are proud to have supported the Makwassi-Hills Local Football Association by assisting them to register their clubs in the SAB Regional League, which is the 4th tier of South African soccer and the 2nd-highest tier controlled by the South African Football Association.

The league consists of 832 clubs, divided into 52 leagues, and the winners of the regional league will enter into a series of play-offs to gain two places in each provincial league in the SAFA Second Division.

## SMME Graduation

We recently hosted an SMME graduation event to honour entrepreneurs who enrolled in our Enterprise Development programme, 2021 to 2022, and progress the 2022 participants through to the next phase of the programme.

SMMEs gained invaluable benefits from this programme - including access to mentorship and training, networking opportunities, exposure to potential investors, and access to technologies and resources.

Additionally, the graduates also gained a better understanding of the market, knowledge of regulations and compliance requirements, and an increased ability to identify and apply to potential funders.



## Reading Programme Continuing at Full Speed

In partnership with READ Foundation, the implementing partner, our reading programme has continued with the help of a consultant mentor who provides consistent face-to-face mentoring.

The learner assistants have been trained to implement various learning activities aligned with the CAPS curriculum, helping to develop the learners' vocabulary and reading skills. They are also trained in comprehension strategies such as evaluation, summarising, and making inferences.

Quality assurance visits were carried out to all four schools benefiting from this programme, where lesson observations were conducted.

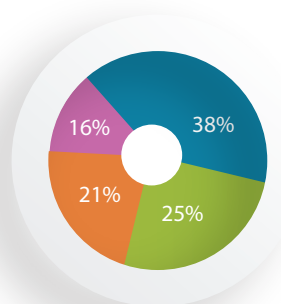
