Two of them have already secured permanent employment, crediting the Bokamoso Solar reading programme for their skills and success.

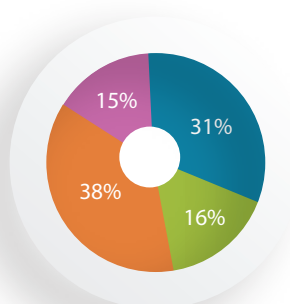
