BRINGING SMILES AND HEALTH TO LOCAL COMMUNITIES


Our school health programme, implemented in partnership with Innovo Mobile Health Clinic, aims to identify and address health barriers for learners and provide locals with access to quality healthcare.

The mobile clinic, in collaboration with the Dr Kenneth Kaunda District Department of Health, offers a range of services to schools and communities, including primary healthcare, oral healthcare, optometry, health education, as well as referrals.

Over 1000 community members benefited from these services with 317 of those receiving spectacles. As a result, the target was exceeded by 77.98% with a recorded client satisfaction of 95%.
